Re: Judge Wendy Duffy nomination hearing

Dear Ms. Tunnell:

I write this letter to both thank you for providing me with some information relevant to the nomination hearing of Judge Wendy Duffy on May 16th, 2005, and also confirm some parts of our conversation of April 15th, 2005.

I understand that I will need to provide by May 9th, 2005, my formal request to provide oral testimony and evidence in opposition to the appointment of Judge Wendy Duffy, with an outline as to the relevancy to the Sixth Appellate Court nomination.

As I explained, I have been in the unenviable position of having to represent myself for the past few years as a civil plaintiff in several related cases in Monterey County culminating in part with my winning an appeal before Justice Conrad Rushing, being arrested by the Judge whose decision I had overturned, and having a heart attack (and next day surgery) in the courtroom of the Judge that I also have said is trying to cover up the crimes of Judge Robert O'Farrell and several other judicial officers and public officials.

All of the judges on the Monterey Superior Court including Judge Wendy Duffy have been requested to intervene according to their judicial canon of ethics code of disciplinary action and should have called for an investigation of my allegations.

Mr. Larry Lichtenegger, a Monterey attorney who had worked either for or with Judge Duffy or her husband when he was with the District Attorney's Office of Monterey County, has stated in legally recorded phone conversations that "judges were sabotaging motions and manipulating trial dates." In other words, judges were "trial fixing."

Mr. James Rummonds, an Aptos attorney that has known me for over 35 years, has said that Judge Richard Silver told him I had been "victimized by attorneys on a number of occasions." However, Judge Silver had been the judge that dismissed the lawsuit I had against Alain Pinel Realtors so that Mr. Dennis McCarthy of the Fenton & Keller Law Firm would not be exposed from fixing a trial with James Cook of the Horan Law Firm.

The document that was hidden and the perjury suborned was denied a protective order by Judge Richard Silver, who then threatened to send me to the DA's for criminal prosecution if I didn't dismiss my civil claim that would expose what they were trying to cover up.

You summarized it as my saying that she was "kind of part of the class"? I responded saying not quite, but in many ways, very much yes. According to the Judicial Canon of Ethics preamble, the number one thing is the fair tribunal and the right of every American to one. Judges are required to request an investigation if they can determine from reliable information that there is potentially a wrong taking place.

A judge in this matter can not say they did not become involved because the case was not over yet, or because it was being handled by another judge. It is like saying they can't do anything until after the person is murdered before their eyes. I have been very vocal and have documented in the court records and via letters the list of wrongs committed. Not once has any one said I am incorrect.


Judge Duffy had been kept informed by myself and had been requested to take corrective or some sort of action to address my assertions that I have been denied a fair tribunal.
