Re: M72599, Forte vs. Judge O'Farrell/Party in Interest/Commission on Judicial Performance & Judge Diana Hall

Dear Mr. Paul Hammerness:

I write this letter requesting that you confirm to me by 4:30PM, today, via fax, if you were representing the interests of Attorney General Bill Lockyer and the Commission on Judicial Performance, in moving to strike and seal, evidence in the case of M72599, Forte vs. O'Farrell, or were you only representing the interests of Judge Robert O'Farrell. Who were you working for? Such information is necessary to determine any and all conflicts that may have not been known to me and not disclosed.

It appears from all reliable newspaper sources that the declaration of Ms. Crystal Powser was stricken on behalf of the CJP, and Attorney General Bill Lockyer to protect their interests in being able to prosecute Judge Diana Hall, I submit, again.

I have taken the position that I have no special interest in Judge Diana Hall's case, but believe that Judge Hall should be entitled to a fair tribunal, as I should, and every other American should.

You have been circulating a grossly inaccurate and beyond a simple stupid mistake minute order of November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2005, of Judge John Golden (the one who says, "I like it misleading") wrongly saying that I was declared a vexatious litigant. I have not been provided a copy of it from you or the court.

You were videotaped walking out of the locked doors of the filing clerks' office before hours that leads to Judge Golden's chambers prior to the hearing on November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2005, and Judge Golden does not want to address it on record. Files are missing from the court.

How many crimes do you think you are allowed to commit prior to your having to be arrested?

At any rate, the recent denial of Judge Hall's request for dismissal of future hearings bring to the forefront that new judges need to be assigned by either the judicial council, Chief Justice George or someone else within the California judicial system. The problem is the top officials of the state including Chief Justice George, AG Lockyer and Governor Schwarzenegger have to explain, and handle the conflicts that are now glaringly obvious in my case. They certainly cannot be assigning anyone to anything. The process is tainted and corrupted.

I am the person you attempted to have declared a vexatious litigant. You were found to not even have any legal standing to bring it, and were thoroughly defeated. That of course did not stop you and Judge Golden trying to carry off the charade with admittedly misleading orders with the assistance of the Monterey Herald press machine.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the CJP, and attorneys for Judge Diana Hall, so that my position is clear. I believe that the CJP, AG Lockyer, Governor Schwarzenegger, Chief Justice George and members of the Sixth Appellate Court were well aware of my allegations of corruption within the Monterey Superior Court Bench and worked in unison to cover it up instead of investigating it.

I am demanding in the interests of justice and fairness that there be Federal intervention to insure that my right to a fair tribunal is protected. Due to the gravity of the situation to preserve the rights of all Americans to a fair tribunal when there are allegations of public official corruption, the matter demands the highest attention.

Judge Diana Hall is a recipient beneficiary by obtaining a process that ensures that a fair tribunal by impartial judges is impaneled for her next trial if it needs to go to that stage.

I submit it certainly cannot be Chief Justice George, or anything grown out of the California Judicial system at present. The record in my case, and apparently from what Judge Diana Hall believes in her case, suggests something is very seriously wrong and need to be addressed.

I will look forward to your response.
