SUBJECT: USC TITLE 18 §§ 4. Misprision of felony

“Whoever, having knowledge of the actual commission of a felony cognizable by a court of the United States, conceals and does not as soon as possible make known the same to some judge or other person in civil or military authority under the United States, shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more than three years, or both.”

This is my formal Notice to you of my specific intent to execute a proper and lawful Citizen's Arrest, pursuant to the pertinent California Revised Statutes, upon the body of your Person, for your several felony violations of applicable state and federal criminal codes in connection with your not reporting for investigation the substantial and reliable information submitted to you in the certified letter attached dated November 8th, 2005, concerning the obstruction of justice by District Attorney Dean Flippo, ADA Terry Spitz, Commissioner Richard Rutledge and members of the Executive Committee of the Monterey Superior Court in case number MAR125367, Forte vs. DA Flippo and ADA Spitz, and their subsequent investigation of Commissioner Richard Rutledge for obstruction of justice.

Probable cause for same has already been properly, and thoroughly documented in prior written communications already mailed to you, via certified United States Mail; filed in the case of Forte vs. Judge Robert O'Farrell, M72599.

Please do not resist arrest, because you can and will be held liable even further for this additional violation. Pursuant to the holding of the United States Supreme Court in the case of Miranda v. Arizona, you are hereby informed that you have the Right to remain silent; you have the Right to an attorney; and anything which you say, or do, from this point forward, can and will be held against you in a court of Law.

I have requested that you provide dates available for the effectuation of such arrest in a letter dated January 3rd, 2006. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation.
